Cassandra Lloyd, a native of Springfield, Ohio, finished a decorated career at Wright State University in the spring of 2012. Lloyd dominated the Horizon League in the 100m and 60m hurdles, was undefeated in both events, and broke the Horizon League record each year. Named a Second Team All-American as a junior after finishing ninth at the national meet, Lloyd became WSU's first Division I All-American in track. She also qualified for the NCAA regionals all four years. Lloyd placed 19th overall in the 100m hurdles at the NCAA National Meet in 2012 with a time of 13.36. As a result, she was named as an Honorable Mention All-American. Lloyd continues to remain involved with WSU Track & Field as a graduate assistant, mentoring, and training with current student-athletes.
